

A GUIDE FROM WDCB ON WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN VISITING WINSLOW HIGH STREET

As lockdown measures are slowly easing, many public places have put precautionary measures in place to ensure social distancing and the safety of yourself and their staff. Here are some guidelines for public places within Winslow, but please be aware the situation is constantly changing.

Currently, wearing face masks is not compulsory when shopping, except when specifically stated. This may change in upcoming weeks, as it has become compulsory in Scotland, so we advise that you keep a face mask and a bottle of hand sanitiser at hand at all times.

SURGERIES & MEDICAL PRACTICES

Please call to make an appointment or an enquiry rather than walking in in person. Turn up promptly at the time of your appointment, as waiting rooms and seating cannot be used in line with social distancing guidelines.

➤ **Norden House Surgery**

Call on 01296 713434.

You will be asked to wear a face covering when you attend any appointments and staff will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), such as masks and gloves, when necessary.

➤ **Lloyds Pharmacy**

Call 01296 712061.

Only 2 people are allowed inside at any one time, you will be asked to queue outside when it is busy, operating on a one out one in basis.

➤ **Windmill Veterinary Centre**

Call on 01296 715660.

No humans are allowed in the surgery, you will be met in the car park and your pet will be taken inside by a member of staff.

Medications and prescriptions can also be picked up in the car park by prior arrangement. Call the surgery on arrival and a member of staff will come out to assist.

➤ **White House Dental Practice**

Call on 01296 712264.

Upon arrival, you will be required to use hand sanitizer and your temperature will be checked. Staff will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), such as masks and gloves, when necessary.

➤ **Winslow Dental Practice**

Call on 01296 712548.

You must wear a face covering when attending the practice and you will be required to use hand sanitizer upon arrival. Staff will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), such as masks and gloves, when necessary.

➤ **Brian Clark Opticians**

Call on 01296 712043.

Patients will be pre-screened by telephone for Covid-19 symptoms before their appointment. They politely request that patients wear face masks during their visit. Staff will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), such as masks and gloves, when necessary.

LOCAL SHOPS

Most shops now have 2 metre markers on the floor to signify where you should stand, and will have Perspex screens at check-out counters. You will often be expected to queue in a socially distanced manner during busy times.

➤ **Co-op, Londis & One Stop**

Limited numbers are allowed inside, when busy there will be a queue, operating on a one out one in basis.

➤ **Post Office (inside One Stop)**

Is open on all weekdays excluding Thursday, 9.00am till 5.30pm. Open on Saturdays 9.00am till 12.30pm. They do close for lunch.

➤ **Butchers, Farm Deli & Small Shops**

Only one customer allowed inside at any one time, you will need to queue outside when busy.

➤ **Winslow Market**

Entry is controlled by marshals who will limit the number of people allowed on the square at any one time. Be prepared to queue.

➤ **Hairdressers and Barbers**

Are allowed to open from Saturday 4th July.

Call and book your appointments rather than walking in in person. Instructions will be given to you during your phone call, as they may differ in their procedures from salon to salon.

➤ **Charity Shops**

Remain closed until further notice.

➤ **TSB Bank**

Opening hours are Monday – Friday, 10.00am till 12.30pm & 1.30pm till 4.00pm. Only 2 people are allowed inside the branch at any one time, you then have to queue outside, operating on a one out one in basis.

➤ **Library**

Is only open on Mondays and Wednesdays, 10am till 1pm. A maximum of 6 people are allowed inside at any one time. You must use hand sanitizer upon entry. There is NO seating inside.

➤ **Winslow Town Council**

The office is closed. Please contact the clerk on 01296 712448 or clerk@winslowtowncouncil.gov.uk.

➤ **Public Transport**

Government guidelines still recommend using public transport for essential travel ONLY. Numbers are limited on all routes. You must wear face coverings AT ALL TIMES.

➤ **Other Larger Supermarkets**

Many large supermarkets allow a limited number inside which will be monitored by staff, operating in on one out one in basis. Be prepared to queue outside during busy times. Most will have staff cleaning trolleys on arrival or they will provide materials for you to use and clean trolleys yourself. Tesco's operate one-way aisles with arrows on the floor for you to follow.
